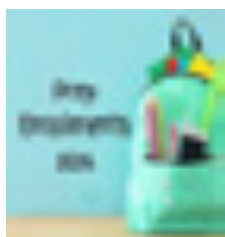

Tickets for these performance go on sale from Ticketek from Thursday 31st July for anyone wishing to purchase them.

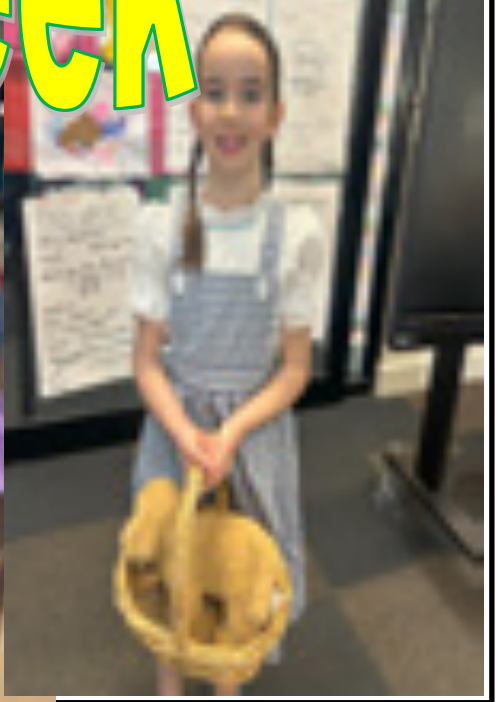
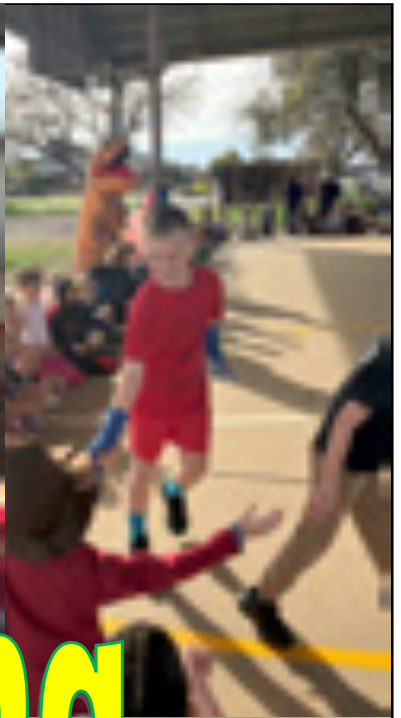
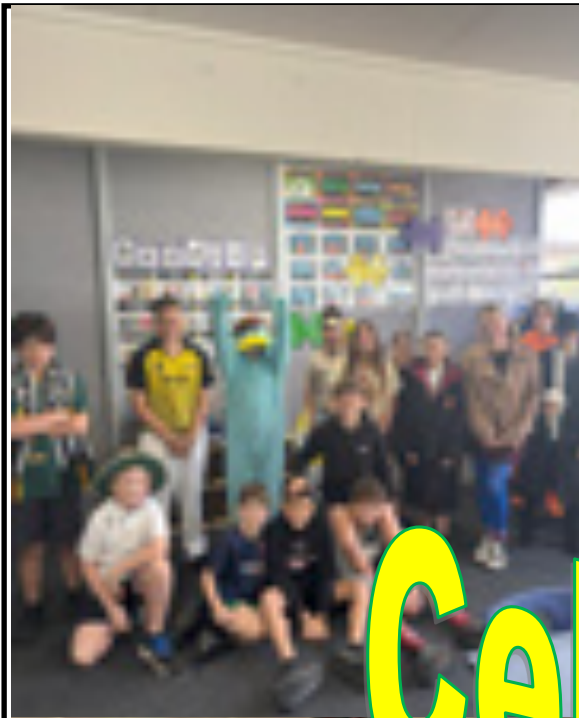
