

Zombie Fish Make a Splash! Years 5 & 6 Dive into Environmental Education Day

On Thursday 1st May, our Years 5 and 6 students spent the morning at Victoria Park Lake in Shepparton for Environmental Education Day, organised by RiverConnect Education. It was a hands-on, outdoor learning experience focused on our local environment.

We started the day with some stretches on the grass to get our bodies moving before jumping into a variety of activities. The weather was great, and everyone was excited to be outside.

During the morning, students took part in a range of sessions run by environmental groups. Each activity was designed to teach us something new and help us better understand the animals and environments that surround us.

RiverConnect staff taught us about endangered native fish that are being reintroduced into our local waterways. Students took part in a matching activity, where they had to use clues and facts to identify different fish species. It was a fun way to learn about each fish and understand why protecting them is so important.

Goulburn Murray Landcare ran a session about native animals, and we also played a fun game called Biodiversity Twister to learn more about ecosystems.

The Goulburn Broken Catchment Management Authority ran a session all about water bugs. We collected water from the lake and looked closely to find tiny invertebrates living in it. The types and number of bugs we found helped us learn how healthy the lake water is.

A major highlight of the day was the opportunity for some students to help release several native fish species into the lake, including the Southern Purple Spotted Gudgeon (also known as the Zombie Fish), Southern Pygmy Perch, and the Flathead Galaxias. The Zombie Fish was once thought to be extinct but was rediscovered 15 years ago. Thanks to the Native Fish Australia breeding program, these fish are now being reintroduced to the Shepparton Lake to help increase the region's biodiversity.

We're also proud of Ivy Wilkinson, who did a great job representing our school when she spoke to ABC Radio about the day.

Thank you to our amazing parent helpers; Sheree Laws, Sarah Rovers, and Anna Carrafa, for coming along and supporting us on the day.

Overall, it was a great morning to be outside, learning about nature, and seeing how we can help care for the environment around us.
